## 2025 Honorees Rory and Rosi Cooper, Human Engineering Research Laboratories

Rory A. Cooper, Ph.D. is a U.S. National Medal Laureate having been awarded the National Medal of Technology and Innovation from President Biden in 2023. Cooper is Founding Director and VA Senior Research Career Scientist of the Human Engineering Research Laboratories (HERL), a VA Rehabilitation R&D Center and a VA Technology Transfer Assistance Program lead site.

In 1988, he was a bronze medalist in the Paralympic Games. Cooper is a U.S. Army veteran and a Director of the Paralyzed Veterans of America Research Foundation. Cooper has authored or co-authored peer-reviewed journal publications. He has patents awarded/pending. Cooper is author of two books and co-editor of four books. He serves on the National Board of Directors of Easterseals.

**Rosemarie 'Rosi' Cooper, MPT** is Associate Director for Stakeholder Engagement at HERL. She is a RESNA certified Assistive Technology Professional (ATP). She is employed at the University Pittsburgh in the School for Health and Rehabilitation Science as Associate Professor and Instructor within the Department of Rehabilitation Science Technology. Rosi has been an author on several articles on wheelchairs and seating. She serves on the Easterseals Western and Central Pennsylvania Board of Directors.

The Human Engineering Research Laboratories (HERL) are a joint venture between the University of Pittsburgh's School of Medicine and the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. They work in all aspects of the Assistive Technology research cycle, from conducting studies to developing physical, medical-grade products. Their labs offer a one-of-a-kind setting for developing solutions for people with disabilities by people with disabilities. Their mission is to continuously improve the mobility and function of people with disabilities through advanced engineering in clinical research and medical rehabilitation.



## 2025 Pittsburgh Ambassador, Aubrey

**Aubrey** is an adorable student attending Easterseals Western and Central PA's Approved Private School Program. If you were to ask Aubrey's teachers or therapists what she

likes most about school, they would tell you that she likes any toy that lights up or plays music, any object that has a touch screen, and the swing in the physical therapy room.

Aubrey has Kabuki Syndrome, a rare genetic condition that affects 1 out of 32,000 births worldwide. Aubrey's symptoms include global development delay, low muscle tone, feeding difficulties, astigmatism, seizures during infancy, and Autism. Since attending, Aubrey has progressed so much with her development, including becoming more independent with everyday tasks and activities, and being able to express her needs and wants with nonverbal communication techniques.
